Overview

The Australian Research Council (ARC) Australian Centre for Excellence in Antarctic Science (ACEAS) will be a national-scale, University-led, international centre focused on this goal:

To help the world community prepare for climate risks emerging from East Antarctica and the Southern Ocean by integrating knowledge of the ocean, atmosphere, cryosphere and ecosystems, and their interplay.

ACEAS PhD top-up scholarships

Limited funding is available to provide top-up scholarships for students undertaking ACEAS approved PhD projects at the University of Tasmania.

Candidates will be considered and assessed for ACEAS top-up scholarship eligibility (valued at \$5,000 per annum for 3.5 years) upon ranking of the applicants by our GRCs and alignment of the project with ACEAS. Students in receipt of a top-up are also eligible for ACEAS funding of project and operational costs.

Limited funding means that some ACEAS affiliated PhD students will not receive an ACEAS top-up. Students not successful in obtaining a top-up will remain affiliated with ACEAS and will be invited to various ACEAS events but will not be eligible for financial support from ACEAS.
