Enhancing take-up of Antarctic scientific research findings

0900 Start | Day's instructions

Step 1: Split into three groups of researchers in similar fields (eg. ACEAS Program 1, Program 2 and Program 3)

Step 2: Decide and discuss

- what your research has found (eg. ocean is acidifying/ice shelves calving)
- what the impact will be on the Southern Ocean/permitted activities/scientific research
- what the options are for addressing the problem
- what the Australian government should present to an ATCM or CCAMLR
- who will lead the writing

Step 3: Prepare a 1–2 page objective (rather than advocacy) policy brief for either AAD's head of delegation to ATCM or AAD's CCAMLR head of delegation on a topic that you think should be presented at the meeting
